Roman Sokolov born in Leningrad (St.Petersburg), USSR in 1989 and began his studies in visual arts at 13. Later, In his first year in the Faculty of Photojournalism, he became a photographer for TimeOut Petersburg magazine and got surrounded by the city's cultural life.

For a years, Roman considered personal photography as an unconscious way of self-expression. In 2018, he worked with Danish photographer Jens Juul as an assistant and translator. The work with diverse artists and studies of contemporary photography influenced Roman, leading him to explore the connection between people and environment in his work.

From 2020 to 2022 Roman worked on the photo project dedicated to the Pulkovo astronomical observatory. For some months he lived in the observatory itself. Being guided by astronomers, Roman also studied the fundamentals of philosophy and began a broad ecological research.

In 2022 Roman worked for Libération and Arte in Istanbul, where he also took part in Mads Nissen and Mads Greve DMJX workshop. In September 2022 he moved to Denmark and was admitted to the Danish School of Media and Journalism, graduating in 2023. During his studies, Roman took part in the Skaftfell art residency with the support of Leica Camera Berlin.
